VIDEOS

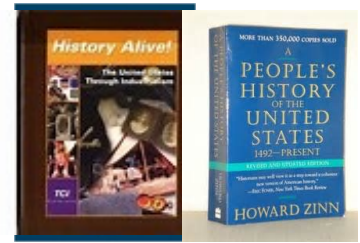

black ball point pen



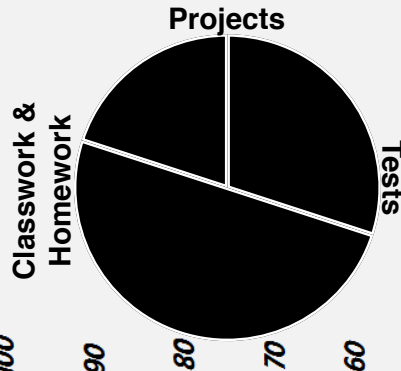
And a container (shoebbox, plastic box etc)_ to store everything in on the top half of your locker.
